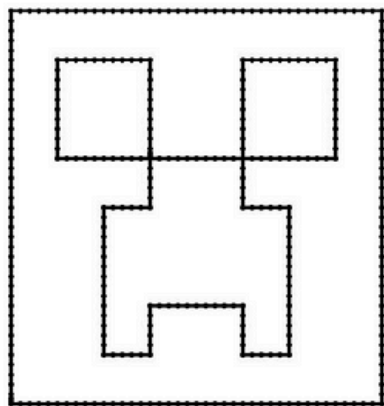

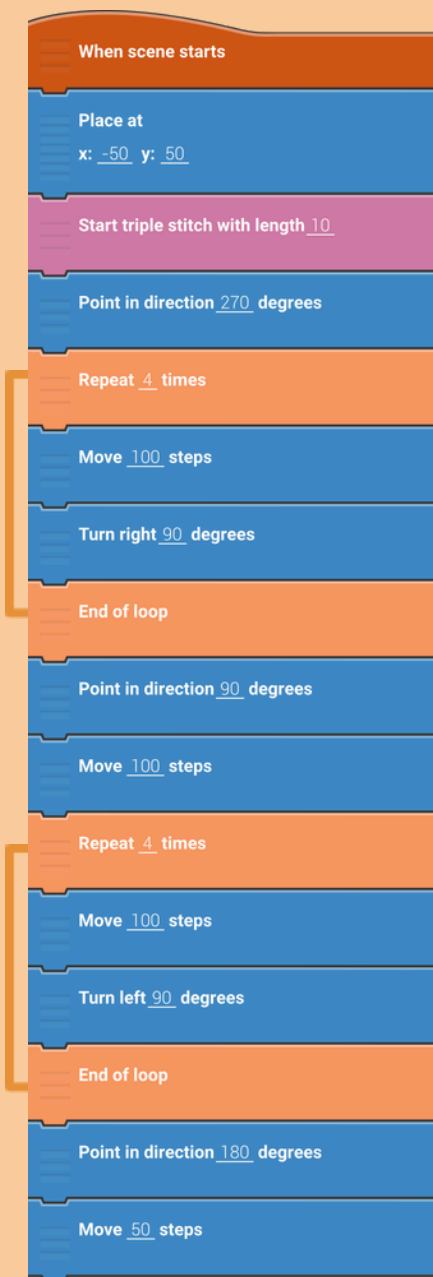
Face Part 1

Create a new Embroidery-Object (see '**Create Embroidery-Objects**') and insert the following scripts:

This will be the face of your creeper.

Add this part to your script from page 2 as well:

Point in direction <u>90</u> degrees
Move <u>50</u> steps
Point in direction <u>180</u> degrees
Move <u>150</u> steps
Point in direction <u>270</u> degrees
Move <u>50</u> steps
Point in direction <u>0</u> degrees
Move <u>50</u> steps
Point in direction <u>270</u> degrees
Move <u>50</u> steps
Point in direction <u>0</u> degrees
Move <u>150</u> steps
Point in direction <u>90</u> degrees
Move <u>50</u> steps
Point in direction <u>2</u> degrees
Move <u>50</u> steps



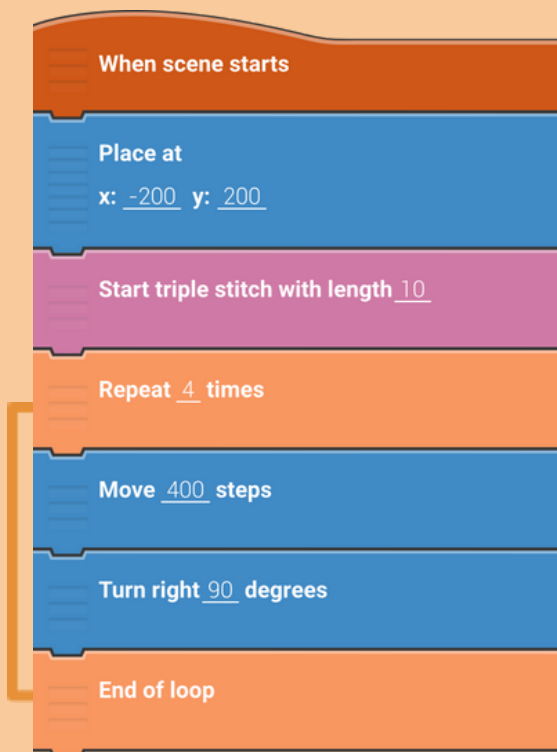
