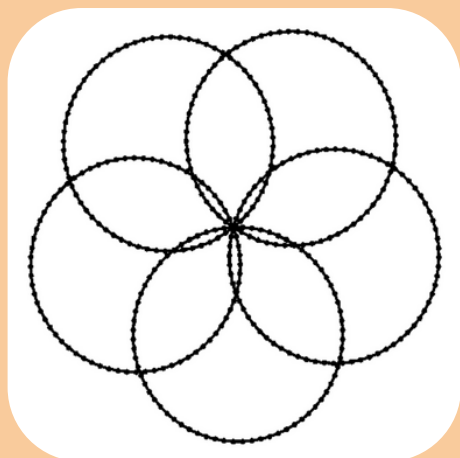

Basic Structure

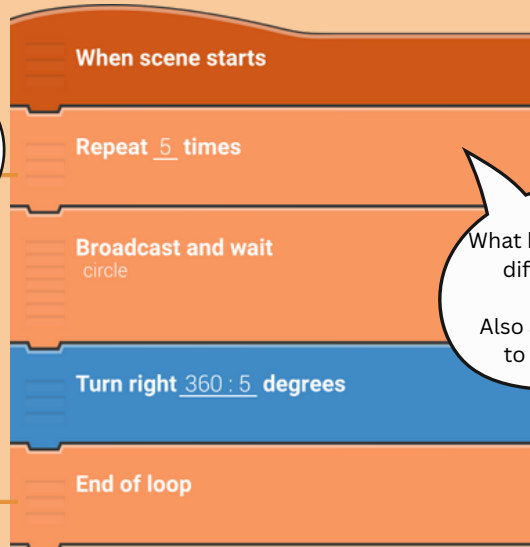

You can embroider a flower using the broadcast function.

1

Create a new Embroidery-Object (see '**Create Embroidery-Objects**') and insert the following script:

Tap "new" to create a new message.
Then choose a name.



What happens if here is a different number?
Try it out!
Also adjust the degrees to the repetitions!

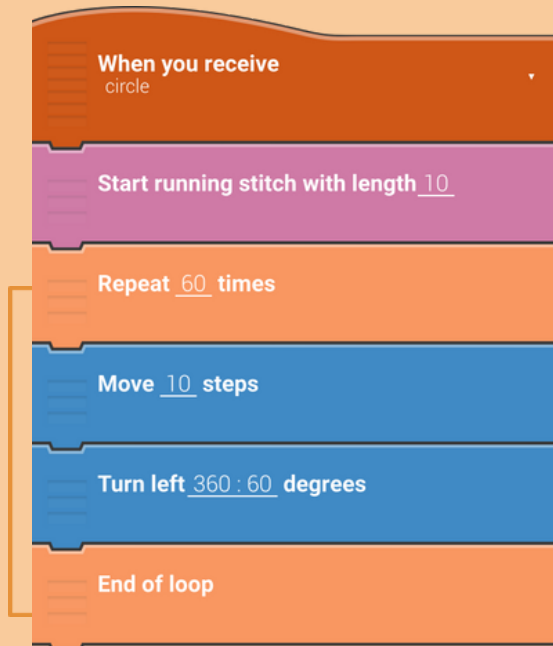

This part is called every time the circle message is sent. Add it to your script too.

Tap play to start your design!



Broadcast function:

Using the broadcast function, you can outsource a part of your script and call it whenever you need it by sending the corresponding message. You can imagine that the program copies the outsourced part to all the places where you send the message. This saves you some programming work, as you only have to program the part once. This can be very helpful, especially with larger programs.
